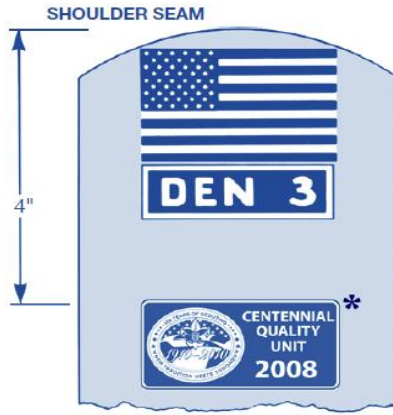

<input type="checkbox"/>		Cub Scouts wear badges of rank as shown: Bobcat, Tiger Cub, Wolf, and Bear.
<input type="checkbox"/>		<i>Gold Arrow Points are worn beneath the pocket and below the badge for which they were earned.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<i>Silver Arrow Points are worn below the Gold Arrow Points in double rows.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<i>Wear medals just above the pocket seam, and service stars centered just above medals or knots, or 3/8 inch above seam if no medals are worn.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<i>Gold background disks are worn with service stars for Cub Scouting service, including Tiger Cub service.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<i>Not more than five medals may be worn.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<i>The only knots worn by Cub Scouts are the religious emblem knot and a lifesaving or meritorious award knot.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<i>The World Crest is worn centered between the left shoulder seam and the top of the left pocket.</i>

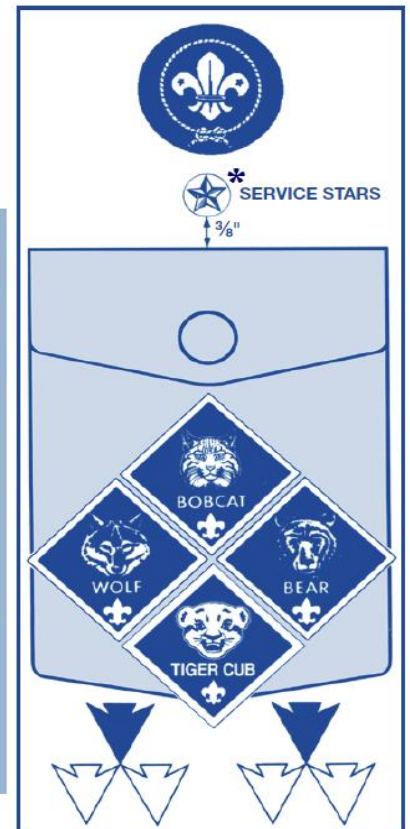
